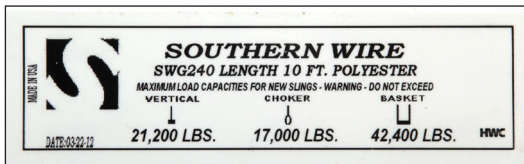
### FLAT WEB MATERIAL OPTIONS

9800# Heavy Duty Nylon Webbing:	Suitable for most applications.
9800# Polyester Webbing:	Suitable for most applications. Polyester stretches less for better load control.
7000# Light Duty Nylon Webbing:	An economical alternative for lighter applications.
9800# Reinforced Edge Webbing:	These nylon web slings have polymer coated yarns woven into the edges to reduce damage and increase life.

### CUSTOM PRINTED TAGS

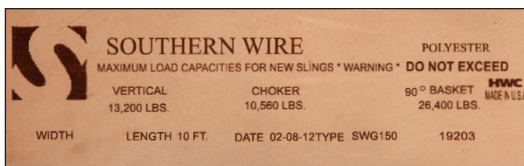
Southern Wire can custom print tags in Polyethylene and leather. Both types have unique qualities, depending upon customer preference. **(Private label programs available)**

#### Polyethylene



These durable tags are printed on demand by Southern Wire. Polyethylene tags offer customers greater flexibility and can be serialized, customized with company logos, and bar coded; there is no minimum quantity or premium charge for polyethylene tags.

#### Leather



Leather is the most durable of the two tags. Leather tags can be branded with serial numbers and other identifying information specific to your company. It carries a premium charge and can be purchased in any quantity.

### WEAR PROTECTION

Wear protection prolongs the life of the sling, ultimately resulting in cost effectiveness. Southern Wire utilizes four wear materials. Pukka (a 5/16" felt pad, as shown), leather, Cordura, and nylon, which can be used in any of the following configurations:

- Eye or Body Wrapped Slings
- Edge guard treatment, protects from edge abrasion
- Lined eye, protects the sling at lifting point
- Velcro sliding pad, easily removable
- Sewn-on sleeve, attached to sling
- Sliding sleeve, adjustable
